Grants for the development of feature films, documentaries and TV films within an International coproduction.

The project must involve an executive production with its head office in France or in the EU. All Production companies may apply to this grant if the project is submitted to a coproduction or codevelopment contract between this company and a foreign company.

Minimum amount: 15 000 € maximum amount: 20 000 €

The grant is to be used for scouting, rewriting, networking with distributors, broadcasters and partners especially if they are foreign.
